THE RULES

- All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form, including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Breeder's/Family, Open or Working Conformation.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes. If an Affiliate sponsored trial is chaired by Committee, all on the Committee may enter their Terriers in any phase of the competition.
- 9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed. Flexi-leashes are strongly discouraged!
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-checking the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office 410-561-3655), or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
- 23. THE JUDGE'S DECISION CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

Notice to Exhibitors ~ NO LOOSE DOGS!

- <u>NO FLEXI LEADS</u> - 4' or 6' leashes only permitted on trial site. Be mindful of where your dog is at all times.

- A copy of your 2020 JRTCA Membership card must be submitted with your entries, faxed before the trial or shown at the entry table. If you have not done one of the above, you will NOT be allowed to compete.

Copies of Certificates in Championship GTG, Super Earth, Agility and Working terriers must be submitted with entry forms.

Children MUST be supervised by an adult at all times. KEEP TERRIERS AWAY FROM THE REGISTRATION TABLE!

Please travel with your health records for ALL of your terriers and have a signed rabies certificate from your vet.

- Homemade concession food (breakfast & lunch) is available at site - catered by Annie Mae's BBQ & Burger.

- **ABSOLUTELY no puppies under 3 months. Questions as to age of puppies will be resolved in favor of the puppies' general well**-being, and you will be asked to remove them from the trial site, including RV area.

Well-behaved and restrained "alternative breeds" may attend with <u>approval from a Trial Administrator</u>; however, they will not be allowed within any posted area, or within 50 feet of any event so as not to disturb the exhibitors. Please contact the Trial Administrator for permission.

Exhibitors must sign the waiver when submitting entry forms.

- No refunds will be given for missed classes. Pay attention, and if you need help handling dogs...ask for it.

Any exhibitor found to be in violation of any of these policies will be disqualified and no refund given.

- No grooming at ringside!! Please limit grooming at the trial site. Grooming at hotels/motels is not allowed.

The Leon County Expo Center trial site is located on 3637 County Road 305 in Buffalo, TX 75831. Fairgrounds Manager - Gene Darby (903-390-8313). Call Jean Wallwin or David Dernick if you need directions or have a question.

From Houston Intercontinental Airport - Depart towards Terminal Road S., 0.1 miles; bear right onto Terminal Road S., 0.2 miles; bear right onto JFK Blvd/John F. Kennedy Blvd, 2.3 miles; take ramp on right and follow signs for Pay Toll/Hardy Toll Road (Toll road, stop for tolls), 2.9 miles; take ramp on right for Hardy Toll Road North toward the Woodlands, 11.9 miles; keep straight onto I-45 North, 91.4 miles; at exit 164, take ramp right for TX-7 towards Centerville, 0.3 miles; turn right onto TX-7/W Saint Mary's Street, 0.5 miles; turn left onto TX-75/N. Commer Street, 9.2 miles; turn left onto County Road 305—0.1 miles.

<u>From Austin</u> - Depart Presidential Blvd. toward Cardinal Loop, 0.9 miles; take ramp on right and follow sign for TX-71 East, 1.7 miles; take ramp left for TX-130-Toll North/TX-45 Toll North toward Waco (Toll Road, stop for tolls), 20.8 miles; keep straight onto TX-130 N. Toll, 4.6 miles, at exit 423, take ramp on right toward Round Rock/Taylor, 0.7 miles; turn right onto road, 0.1 miles, take ramp on left and follow signs for US-79 North (pass Ford/Chevrolet in 3.1 miles), 6.5 miles; keep straight onto US-79 E TRUCK, 2.0 miles; take ramp on right for US-79 North toward Rockdale (pass Shell in 5.3 miles), 54.1 miles; take ramp on right for US-79 North/TX-6/S. Market Street, 1.9 miles; keep left to stay on US-79 E/TX-6S, 438 ft; keep left onto US-79 N/TX-6 S., 0.1 miles; road name changes to US-79 EAST/TX-6 SOUTH (pass Exxon in 10.8 miles), 0.2 miles; bear right onto TX-75/S. Buffalo Avenue, 6.4 miles; turn right onto County Road 305.

Stemmons Freeway, 0.7 miles; At exit 428A, take ramp left for I-30 East towards Texarkana, 1.3 miles; At exit 46, take ramp right for I-45 South toward Houston, 105.6 miles; At exit 180, take ramp right for TX-164 toward Groesbeck, 0.3 miles; Turn left onto TX-164, 1.2 miles; Bear right onto TX-75/N. 

<u>Class 133/331</u> **10" up to 12.5" SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG**. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTC Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Under GTG Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 134/332</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Over GTG Champion & Reserve.

DIVISION G: SUPER EARTH (CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES)

<u>Class 142/340</u> **Over 12.5" up to 15" ADULT CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH**. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. & older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Adult Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 143/341 10" up to 12.5" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 6 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 144/342</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH.</u> Open to any JRT 6 years or older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 145/343 10" up to 12.5" SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 146/344</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" SENIOR CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH</u>. Open to any JRT 9 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

DIVISION H: AGILITY (ABSOLUTELY NO FLEXI-LEADS) Section 1

\$5.00 Practice runs begin @ 9:00 AM - Pay At Gate ~ ***Terriers must be one year old or older to compete in Agility***

<u>Class 147/345</u> AGILITY III CERTIFICATE: Off-Lead. Time 3.00 + 10%. Course to include all Agility I and II equipment. Weave poles are increased to 12 and must end in a "gamble." Qualifying score will be 200. Gamble set to 8-10 feet. No cross-entering into Class 149/347.

<u>Class 148/346</u> AGILITY II CERTIFICATE: Off-Lead. Time 2.25 +10%. More difficult course to include all of the Agility I equipment plus two more hurdles, weave poles, and see-saw. Qualifying score of 190 or better earns one leg towards JRTCA Agility II Certificate. No cross-entering into 149/347.

<u>Class 149/347</u> AGILITY I CERTIFICATE: Off-Lead. Time 1.75% + 10%. Handlers may remain in this class. Open to any adult terrier. All three legs of Agility I Certificate are earned with three qualifying scores of 190 or above. Three qualifying scores may move entrant of this class onto Agility II, III and Jumpers/Games. This course is used for Youth Agility On-Lead. No see-saw or tire jump in this class. May not cross-enter into 147/345 & 148/346.

<u>Class 150/348</u> Jumpers/Game – Off-lead. Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels with at least one lead change. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st regardless of number of faults. Five faults for running course on-lead; five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. 15 faults for missed obstacle. Qualifying score of 200 earns one leg towards a JRTCA Jumpers/Game Certificate.

<u>Class 151/349</u> <u>AGILITY HIGH SCORE CHAMPION & RESERVE</u> To be awarded to the high score terrier and runner-up combining scores of Agility II, Agility III and qualifying no fault score in Jumpers/Game (Classes 147,148 & 150/345,346 & 348). Ties are broken by fastest time. No entry fee.

Section 2 Agility On-Lead Classes (ABSOLUTELY NO FLEXI-LEADS) NOTE: Terriers entered in Novice & Advanced On-Lead classes may not cross enter Off-Lead Classes.

<u>Class 152/350</u> JUMPERS ON-LEAD – Consists of 12-17 jumps and/or tunnels. Scoring is time plus faults, with lowest score getting 1st, regardless of number of faults. Five faults for knocked bar, and off-course. 15 faults for missed obstacle. (Non-Sanctioned)

<u>Class 153/351</u> NOVICE ON-LEAD - Time YPS 150. Open to any adult terriers which have not scored above 190 pts. This class is for the true beginner terrier with the intent of a pleasant experience on the basic agility equipment. Handlers who drag their terriers around will be seriously faulted. Course to include ramps, tunnels, and various hurdles. (Although this class is for the beginner, terrier needs to have prior exposure to Agility equipment.) May not enter off-lead classes at this trial.


HELP SUPPORT OUR TROOPS






